- Applications are due **Friday March 19th, 2012 by 4:30pm to the SLC.**
- Applicants will be asked to select an available interview time for **March 22nd, 23rd, or 24th when they drop off their application.** Applicants will be asked to prepare a 3 minute (maximum) presentation on a leadership skill, topic or theory of their choosing. For example, you may choose role modeling, communication skills, team building, conflict mediation, stages of group development, leadership styles, goal setting etc. Interviews will last approximately 30 minutes.
- Emails will be sent on **Tuesday March 27th** to notify applicants of the hiring committee's decision. Successful applicants must sign and return their offer letters by **Friday March 29th** to the SLC.
